



POLY MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

Highprofile Poly is an entry-level shutter that provides a cost effective PVC alternative whilst retaining the timeless look and feel of shutters. They are perfect for price-conscious consumers, particularly those seeking shutters over blinds and other window treatments.

As for all quality products, appropriate cleaning and maintenance is highly recommended.

MAINTAINING YOUR POLY SHUTTERS.

Open the louvres with the middle louvre or tilt rod.

A damp cloth is all that is required for cleaning. You do not need to use any solvents.

Simply wipe the damp cloth over the shutters to remove any dust film.

When closing the shutter panel into the window, gently push the panel until it connects with the magnetic or striker plates on the frame.

TENSIONING.

If required, you can tension the drive blade.

Remove the plastic cap on the side of the panel.

Place a Phillips head screwdriver into the hole and gently turn clockwise until you feel the blade has enough tension so that the blades stay in their position.

However, be very careful not to over tension the drive blade as this is not covered under warranty.
